- Resume of activities and achievements over the past two years
- Copies of school reports for the past two years and Naplan results
- Contact details of previous teacher(s)

Selected candidates will then be invited to an interview with the Principal. Interviews will be held Between Friday 29 March and Thursday 3 April 2019.
